Edgebrook Historical Society March 8

Assistant Civil Engineer Dylan Cooney will give the presentation to the Edgebrook Historical Society on Tuesday, March 8, 2016, at 7:00 p.m. The topic will be the Tunnel and Reservoir Plan, commonly known as the Deep Tunnel. This project was designed for pollution control and to alleviate flooding. Some of these tunnels are buried in our own neighborhood! They save more than \$130 million in annual flood damage and have a total

system storage of 20.5 billion gallons! The Deep Tunnel's service area encompasses 352 square miles and more than 1.5 million structures are better protected because of it. The project is a series of 109.4 miles of tunnels that connect to reservoirs. Combined sewers, which receive water from homes, businesses, and the roadways, can become overburdened during heavy rainstorms. The Deep Tunnel was designed to assist with that prob-

lem. The Deep Tunnel reduces flooding and improves water quality in the local waterways. Questions are welcome. The meeting will be held at the Volunteer Resource Center, 6100 N. Central and refreshments will be served. All are welcome.
