Mature Height	Large: 70–80'
Mature Width	spread of around 80'
Form	Rounded




PIN OAK

RED OAK


quercus rubra

Growth in First 10 yrs Light Required Ideal Digging Season Ideal Soil Type

Slow: less than 12" per year Full Sun Spring or Fall Tolerates Acid Soils Prefers Alkaline Soils

Fast: more than 24" per year Full Sun Spring or Fall Requires Acid Soils Intolerant to Alkaline Soils

Full Sun or Partial Shade Spring or Fall Tolerates Acid Soils Moderate Alkaline Soil Tolerance
