# Need for Updating Long-Term O&M Programs

CMOM requirements USEPA's proposed SSO rule making Aging/aged infrastructure Check on resources and funding Picture from Annual Summary Reports

- Deficient public sector monitoring
- Almost negligible private sector monitoring
- Deficient sewer system mapping

### **Elements of New LTO&M Programs**

- Resource allocation
- Sewer system mapping
- Monitoring sewer system
  - Public sector inspection cycle
  - Private sector inspections
  - Periodic verification of flows
- Annual Summary Reports
- Asset condition assessment



## **Updating LTO&M Programs**

- Include Resources and sewer system mapping as part of ASR
- Enforceable sewer system monitoring requirements
- Spot checking sewer system flows periodically
- Focus on private sector I/I sources
- Emphasize record keeping
- Focus on replacing aged/aging assets



#### **Resources and Assets**

- Manpower allocated to sewer system O&M
- Funds collected and spent for the sewer system
- Sewer Atlas
  - Update every 10 years
  - Detail every sewer segment (diameter, length, inverts, etc.)
  - Assign MH numbers
  - Detail other appurtenances (e.g., lift station number, its capacity)
  - GIS interface
  - Web posting



## Condition Assessment and Scheduling

- 10-yr cycle
- Identify defects/failures and illegal connections
- Develop maintenance, rehabilitation, and/or replacement recommendations
- Identify funding needs
- Schedule maintenance, rehabilitation, and/or replacement projects proactively



#### **Policies and Quality Controls**

- Clear ordinances/regulations governing quality of construction, specifying permitting, and inspection requirements
- Ordinances mandating private sector I/I removal
- Long-term policies for removal of high-cost I/I sources
- Policies of private-public cost-sharing arrangements
- Policies for aged asset replacement
