# Private Sector Inspections Ordinance Language

## Concept

- It was evident that meaningful I/I reduction cannot be achieved without addressing private sector sources
- There seemed a near consensus among ATP members that the "direction/drive" for private property inspections must come from the MWRD
- All parties supported idea that the MWRD should enact an ordinance requiring such inspections



### **Development of Ordinance Language**

- A few ATP members volunteered to help
- MWRD prepared initial draft based on the past discussions with the ATP
- Members submitted their comments
- The draft presented today has been developed after several rounds of comments (emails) and a teleconference

## **Comments by ATP Members**

- We urge you to evaluate the ordinance language and submit your comments by end of January 2013
- Municipalities submit comments through your respective COGs and specify a representative per COG
- Others submit comments directly to Maureen Durkin



## Private Property Inspections Training of Inspectors

- Overview of administrative setup
- Overview of currently available training/certification
- Potential for regional cooperation in development of a training/certification program



## **Flow Monitoring**

- MWRD is considering contracting services of a flow monitoring company
- When agencies require flow meters within their system (short-term basis), agencies would request MWRD to arrange for company to install meters, then provide raw data. MWRD would fund internet hosting of data
- Agencies would reimburse MWRD for the cost of meter installation, maintenance, data collection and equipment removal
- How many agencies would be interested in such a service?



## **Potential Funding Sources**

- MWRD's own Local Loan Assistance
  Program
- IEPA's SRF Loan Program (Possibility that MWRD may help administer IEPA's loan program locally)
- How many agencies will be ready/willing to make use of this funding?
