The vendor fair, entitled "Diversity Today, Success Tomorrow," will include presentations from MWRD's executive staff and guest speakers who will share their success stories on becoming new vendors, experiencing work opportunity increases and how they made the transition from subcontractors to prime contractors. This will be the MWRD's third vendor outreach fair in just over eight months, bringing together dozens of firms and

government agencies to introduce firms to the various opportunities to grow their businesses and achieve goal attainment.
