This letter transmits information for the 2012 report of the Fulton County Environmental Protection System. No biosolids data are reported because supernatant and biosolids applications were terminated in 1995 and 2004, respectively. Termination of monitoring of soil, crops, and surface water and groundwater sites was approved by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency in September 2006 and the coal refuse areas in July 2007. Therefore, no environmental monitoring was required during this period.
